Mensa Semi-Sweet Chenin Blanc 2019

Wine Description

An abundantly fruity, delightfully refreshing wine brimming with ripe flavours.

Vineyards

The vineyards are planted in a wide range of soils, ensuring excellent water retention and contributing structure and fullness to the wines. The vineyards lies on a Northern facing slope.

Winemaking Techniques

All grapes were harvested in the early morning. The grapes were pressed immediately. Following natural settling the juice was fermented in stainless steel tanks at around 14 to 15 degrees Celsius for two weeks. The wine was then racked from the gross lees and remained on the fine lees until just before bottling.

Vintage Conditions

With even budburst and cooler summer conditions gave the 2019 season a start with a slower ripening period. Grapes reached phenolic ripeness with good acidity and lower pH levels. The season was characterised by healthy, full-flavoured grapes.

Food Pairing

Spicy pealla, pasta with a rich Gorgonzola sauce and quiche.
